STATUTE

CHAPTER I

THE ENTITY AND ITS PURPOSES

Article 1 - The WORLD ESPORTS CONSORTIUM, designated by the acronym WESCO, or WESCO Esport, is an international association and consortium constituted as a private organization, non for profit and for profit (mixed organization) that will become full for profit but still remaining its characteristics of not for profit, according to the Brazilian Law of Sports (LEI PELÉ) which gives the possibilities of a "sports not for profit organization" to become between 2019-2020 private without losing its Legal position and characteristics of sports administrative governing body, club and state governing body, leader of the International electronic sport. After this change happens, the entire Statute will go to a modification and will become Bylaw Documents (or regulation documents), with changes in its entire organization from administrative organigram to its operational organogram (work and operational chart).

Paragraph 1 - WESCO, supported by item I of art. 217 of the Federal Constitution and in accordance with the law sport federal, enjoys peculiar autonomy as to its organization and operation, not being subject to interference or state interference, the content of the provisions in paragraphs XVII and XVIII of art. 5º the Constitution Federal.

Paragraph 2º- All the members, organs and members of WESCO, as well as clubs, athletes, referees, coaches, doctors and other leaders belonging to clubs or leagues of associations must observe and comply in Brazil the Statutes, regulations, directives, decisions and WESCO's Code of Ethics.

Paragraph 3 - WESCO shall be actively and passively represented, judicially and extrajudicially, by its Chairman or his legal substitute.

Paragraph 4 - The WESCO, comprising all their powers, organs and officials, not exercise any function delegated to the Government or is characterized as entity or public authority.

Paragraph 5 - WESCO recognizes that the formal practice of electronic sports is regulated by national and international standards and by the rules of the game approved by "WESCO", which it is responsible for observing in an internationally level.

Paragraph 6 - The continental, regional and national federations, national associations, clubs and leagues affiliated, related and subordinate, directly or in

directly to WESCO and this recognized, are obliged to maintain their independence from any external entity, whatever is to your way legal, and , any individual or legal (companies and their subsidiaries) can control more than one club or grouping if this attempt against the integrity of any match or competition.

Paragraph 7 - The WESCO not have activities partisan political or religious, being forbidden discrimination of any kind against one country, one individual or one group of people by prejudice of origin ethnic, color, language, religion, or of any kind of discriminatory behavior and / or that violates human dignity and, if it occurs, will be punished with penalties of suspension, fine, loss of points, prohibition of access to the stadium or exclusion, applicable to players, officials and spectators.

Article 2 - WESCO has its headquarters and venue in the city of Jundiaí, State of Sao Paulo, at Rua Hilda Del Nero Bisquolo, 102, room 1603-02, Ed. The One Office Tower, Jardim Florida, ZIP Code 13206-760, in the city of Jundiai, state of Sao Paulo.

Paragraph 1 - The transfer of WESCO headquarters to outside the geographical territory of the State of São Paulo alone may occur upon the approval unanimously of direct entities (Federations), gathered at the General Meeting specially convened for this purpose.

Article 3 - WESCO has its own legal personality and assets, distinct from those of its members and will have an indefinite term.

Article 4 - WESCO has for its basic purposes:

I. To administer, direct, control, foster, disseminate, encourage, improve, constantly and uniquely and exclusively regulate the practice of non-professional, educational and professional electronic sport throughout the International territory;

II. To coordinate the realization of electronic sport competitions, in any of its forms, in the International context, with the participation of foreign, regional representatives or entities of practice of electronic sport affiliated to the national and regional entities of administration of the sport;

III. Maintain the sports order and ensure the discipline of the practice of electronic sport, in the national and regional entities of administration and entities of practice of electronic sport;

IV. represent the international sport electronic outside in friendly competitions or official;

V. Respect, comply with and enforce the statutes, regulations, guidelines, decisions and other acts originating from WESCO and other international entities to which it is affiliated;

VI. send to affiliates, with the nature of mandatory adoption, any act inherent to the organization, functioning and discipline of the activities of esports that promote, or of which participate;

VII. regulatory provisions legal downloaded about athletes not professional, educational and professional, having, in the exercise of their autonomy on enrollment, registration, including for contract work or provision of services, transfers, removals and reversals, temporary assignments or permanent;

VIII. represent the sport electronic events (events specific statements), directly or through entity manager and developer of franchises of the aforementioned methods and platforms in any competitions International, getting the promotion, in the country of international events sport electronic events when, and if WESCO not want to organize them, subject to its prior authorization, and may this representation or authorization is canceled or suspended, in whole or in part, at any time, the sole criterion of WESCO;

IX decide, with exclusivity on promoting competitions international and regional or national by national and regional bodies of administration and practice of sport electronic and the leagues, perhaps recognized, establishing guidelines, criteria, conditions and limits, without prejudice to keep the authorization of privacy to which such loved sports can participate in competitions character interInternational;

X. take any measures that may be necessary or appropriate to enforce the Rules Game approved by "WESCO " - preventing any violation and ensuring that they are respected by its members and by entities esports practice; apply penalties, within the limits of their attributions, to those responsible for non-compliance with statutory, regulatory and legal rules ;

XI. enforce the removal of entity management of national and regional affiliated or of entity practice of e-sports in the share of e-sports competitions, in cases of emergency and preventive character, which, directly or through a third individual or legal, commits or tolerates violation, disobedience or disregard of the WESCO Statutes , and other current rules approved by WESCO;

XII. intercede with public and private entities for the defense of the legitimate rights and interests of legal and natural persons subject to their jurisdiction;

XIII. represent International electronic sport in any activity of an international nature , subject to the competence conferred, within the limits of sports law , on the International Olympic Committee , with the power to enter into agreements and agreements, as well as to guide, coordinate and supervise the activities of national and regional entities . administration (Federations) and the entities practice of sport electronic (clubs) which they are affiliated, in part international;

XIV. combat by all forms, the use of substances prohibited or technical doping, for part of athletes not professionals and e-sport professionals, punishing the violators of anti-doping rules and the guide procedures doping;

XV. promote seminars, symposiums, courses, forums and other similar activities involving technical, legal, administrative and economic matters directly related to electronic sport;

XVI. conduct promotions and events designed to raise funds for the promotion of electronic sport, through the modalities allowed and expressly permitted by law;

XVII. represent the sport electronic International as member affiliated with the Congress of WESCO, or the IOC and other sports institutions, through its Chairman, delegates and observers;

XVIII. practice, in the exercise of direction International electronic sport, all the acts necessary for the fulfillment of its purposes and may, among other activities, to undertake efforts in the direction of integration of WESCO and the other entities linked to sport electronic, with the various social media any country, in order to contribute to the public awareness of the importance of this sport and to create favorable conditions for its constant development;

XIX collaborate for the operation and development of the affiliated Federations and entities that practice electronic sports, providing them with technical and financial assistance ;

XX. collaborate for the operation and development of entities of a welfare nature .

XXI represent the interests of electronic sport before the Government ;

XXII. to license to any third parties, within or outside the International territory, the properties and trademarks of its ownership, as well as to enter into sponsorship or promotion agreements;

XXIII. keep records of entities affiliated sports, the athletes professional and non - professional participants in official competitions and the agents indirect;

XXIV. prevent that certain methods or practices put into question the integrity of matches or competitions, or deem place to abuses in esports in any of its forms;

XXV. respect and enforce the international calendar prepared by WESCO and comply with the provisions for the organization of international matches and competitions between national teams and between leagues or clubs to be subject to prior authorization from WESCO.

XXVI. participate in competitions organized by the competent international entities ;

XXVII. pay quotas and other financial obligations owed to WESCO;

XXVIII. pay the quotas and other financial obligations due to the competent international entities ;

Paragraph 1 - The rules of implementation of the principles of this Article shall be prescribed, in addition to that contained in this Statute, the regulations, rules, resolutions, ordinances, notices, notes officers and instructions and other organic standards and technical downloaded by WESCO, with character adoption and compliance required.

Paragraph 2 - WESCO, in order to achieve its purposes, may associate itself with other sports institutions of any country, being exclusively responsible for the representation of International electronic sport abroad and especially before WESCO.

Paragraph 3. The execution of all WESCO's activities shall, under any circumstances, observe the principles of legality, impersonality, morality, publicity, economy and efficiency, and shall adopt administrative management practices, necessary and sufficient to curb individual or collective attainment. personal benefits or advantages or in favor of related legal entities as a result of their participation in the respective decision-making process. Similarly, management will ensure that these management principles and standards are observed by employees.

Paragraph 4 All documents and information relating to accountability and management shall be published in full on its website, ensuring all members unrestricted access to documents and information.

Paragraph 4. In compliance with the provisions of art. 3 rd item IX of Ordinance 115/2018, the representation of the athlete category within the scope of the governing bodies and technical councils responsible for the approval and elaboration of the regulations eventually made by them is guaranteed.

Art. 5 The WESCO will be administered with based on practices Governance Corporate, to be implemented by its administrators, contained in Act itself normative or Bylaws, shall in their implementation observe and apply:

- I- principles of democratic management
- II- social control instrument
- III- management transparency in the movement of resources
- IV- internal inspection
- V- alternation in the exercise of the steering
- VI approval

of benefits accounts annually for council direction, preceded the opinion of council tax

VII- participation of athletes in the direction of collegiate charged directly sporting matters and the election for the positions of WESCO

Paragraph 1. For the purpose of ensuring balance in its representativeness, the ratio of athletes to the number of affiliated entities entitled to vote under this Bylaws shall be observed.

Paragraph 2 The composition of the Athletes' Committee shall consist of one representative of each duly accredited affiliate, which shall not be

cumulative. It also guarantees 1/3 (one third) votes to represent athletes in accordance with the provisions of article 18-A of Law 9615/98 regulated by Ordinance 115 of 3/4/2018 .

Art . 6 - The WESCO not have purpose of profit, shall apply its revenues and financial resources, in full, in carrying out its purposes, as well as the organization, the management, the dissemination and the promotion of sport electronic.

CHAPTER II

PATRON

Article 7 - Daniel Cayres Cossi, President and Co-Founder of WESCO, Brazil's Formal Representative in Electronic Sports at WESCO, LATAM Representative for the World Council on Electronic Sports - WeSC, and Member of the Internacional Council of IEGC, is consecrated Patron of WESCO, on a permanent basis, in recognition of the relevant and exceptional services they provide to this Entity.

CHAPTER III

OF SYMBOLS AND INSIGNIA

Art. 8 - WESCO has as insignia the flag, the emblem and the uniforms, with the following characteristics:

I. the flag has the shape of one blue arcs and rounded lines, gray tones and the like, divided into many parts, also can be displayed in colors black and white in the same shapes and formats;

II. the emblem, with the format also spherical, the color blue-gray-black-white, and with the words "WORLD ESPORTS CONSORTIUM" and / or WESCO the side right and other times below the sphere or even to the left side;

III. the uniform will follow the colors existing in the flag and contain the emblem described in section II above, and may vary in accordance with requirements of the climate, in models approved by the Presidency, not being mandatory that each uniform type contains all the colors existing in the flag.

Paragraph 1 - The WESCO can use streamers and pennants with the existing features in the flag and the emblem.

Paragraph 2 - The denomination and use of WESCO's insignia are its absolute and exclusive property, being forbidden to its exploitation by third parties, in any way, except in case of previous and express authorization.

CHAPTER IV

THE ORGANIZATION

Art. 9 - WESCO is constituted by the continental, regional, and national entities of administration of the electronic sport (Federations), by direct affiliation, recognized as exclusive governing entities of the electronic sport, in the scope of the Countries and International, and its National Federations are under the umbrella of Continental, Regional Governing Bodies, and also by the Leagues that by themselves will govern and coordinate, and the entities of the practice of sport electronic (clubs), those affiliates, as members of the First Division Championship International sport electronic Professional and Educational when admitted in as special and affiliated transient. Also private companies and other governmental entities can be part of WESCO as members in their respective category.

Paragraph 1 - Special affiliated and transitional should request their admission in WESCO upon written request addressed to the President, which recorded statement expressed the entity practice (club) that, in addition to fulfill all the requirements of legislation applicable federal sport, commits is to submit and fulfill always the statutes, rules, regulations and decisions of WESCO.

Paragraph 2 - WESCO may, at its sole discretion, admit the binding, on an exceptional and provisional basis, in substitution to the entities of the practice of electronic sport referred to in the caput of this article (special and transient affiliates), of up to two national leagues, integrated, respectively, for all entities sporting practice (clubs) participants of the First and Second Divisions of the International Esports Championship.

Paragraph 3 - The national leagues of the 1st and 2nd Divisions, when and if constituted, to claim to be linked to WESCO must formalize a written request, submitting, beforehand, their respective Statutes and regulations for WESCO's approval, in addition to stating the explicit rule in which they commit themselves. to fully comply with the statutes, rules, regulations, directives and decisions of WESCO and WESCO, to which will be subordinate.

Art. 10 - The statutes of the national and regional entities of administration (Federations) and of practice of the electronic sport (clubs), affiliated to WESCO and the national leagues, if constituted and when admitted in WESCO, shall be subordinate to those of WESCO., whose norms and rules will guide their organization, competence and functioning.

Paragraph 1 - The WESCO not recognize as valid any provisions that regulate the organization and functioning of its members and the national leagues, if established, when conflicting with the Statutes of WESCO.

Paragraph 2 - The entities mentioned in the caput of this article do not may belong or participate in competition in the territory of another International Organization, except in circumstances exceptional, without the permission of the previous acknowledge of WESCO, and the respective Continental and Regional Organizations.

Art . 11 - All entities national, regional and continental administration (federations), the practice of sport electronic (clubs) and alloys, affiliated or related to WESCO, including the agents organizers matches and agents of players licensed, should refrain postulating or recourse to the courts for themselves or making use of a third party or of an intermediary individual or legal, to settle any dispute nature sports or who have or will have with the WESCO and with other similar entities, pledging to accept and comply, as definitive, final and not subject to appeal, the decisions taken by the bodies and authorities competent of WESCO, aware of the penalties that may arise from the application of the code disciplinary WESCO.

Article 11a - WESCO may apply to its affiliates, as well as to individuals or legal entities, directly or indirectly linked to it, without prejudice to the sanctions of jurisdiction of the Sports Justice, the following penalties:

- I - Warning;
- II - Suspension;
- III - Defiliation, and / or untying.

Paragraph 1 - The application of the sanctions provided for in the provisions of this article does not dispense with any administrative proceeding in which the adversarial and the broad defense, ensured by these Bylaws and, alternatively, by the Internal Regulations of the Entity are ensured.

Paragraph 2 - The penalties referred to in items I to III of this article shall only be applied after a final and well-founded decision of the President of WESCO, and a consensus greater than 1/3 of the Board.

Paragraph 3 - The administrative inquiry shall be conducted by a committee appointed by the President of WESCO, and shall have a period of 15 (fifteen) days for its conclusion, extended for another 10 (ten) days if necessary.

Paragraph 4 - Once the investigation has been concluded, it shall be sent to the President of WESCO, who, after its assessment, shall be referred to the Prosecutor of the WESCO Court of Justice under the terms of current legislation.

Paragraph 5 - Except in cases of appeal, the administrative penalties applied by WESCO's competent power may only be commuted or amnesty by the power that applied them.

Paragraph 6 - In the event of final judgment, the officer or administrator convicted of an irregular or reckless act shall be removed from office and prevented from participating in elections for a period of 5 (five) years.

Paragraph 7 - In the event of the vacancy of the powers of any of the affiliates, without the proper fulfillment of the position, within the statutory deadlines, WESCO may appoint a delegate who will promote the fulfillment of the acts previously determined and necessary for the normalization of institutional sports life. and administrative office of its affiliate, for a period not exceeding 120 (one hundred and twenty) days.

Paragraph 8 th - The entities national, regional and continental administration (Federations), sports practice electronic (clubs) and alloys, undertake to fulfill the decisions of the WESCO Justice Sport, always that involve actions related to the discipline and competitions sports .

Art . 12 - In cases of urgency proven and character preventive, the WESCO may decide on the removal of any natural person or legal to it directly or indirectly linked to infringe or tolerates that are violated the norms contained in this or the statutes of WESCO, as well as the rules contained in Regional applicable laws.

Art . 13 - In case of vacancy of the positions of power in any of the direct affiliates without its fulfillment in the statutory deadlines, the WESCO, through the delegate accredited, arrange to make the necessary and indispensable acts on standardization of institutional life, sports and administrative entity to it jurisdiction over .

Article 14 - The obligations contracted by WESCO do not extend to its affiliates, just as the obligations contracted by its affiliates do not extend to WESCO, nor create bonds of solidarity.

Art. 15 - The national, regional and continental electronic sports administration entities (Federations), affiliated to WESCO, must cumulatively fulfill the following requirements:

I. to be a legal entity governed by private law, with or without economic purposes (if Brazilian), through the exercise of free association;

II. be governed by statute and internal regulations compatible with the legislation in force and with the rules and ordinances adopted by WESCO;

III. maintain, in fact and in law, in the direction of electronic sport in the territorial unit of its jurisdiction;

IV. promote the championships and tournaments instituted, with mandatory character, and with strict observance of the dates contained in the annual calendar of the International electronic sport established by WESCO;

V. be current with their financial obligations to the WESCO;

VI. present themselves with powers constituted in accordance with the law;

VII. comply, the quality entity responsible for organizing the games held in the territory of its jurisdiction, all obligations local order technical and administrative necessary and indispensable to the logistics and security of matches e-sports, including those required by Regulation Competitions of technically coordinates by WESCO.

VIII. fill the positions of their bodies or authorities only through the election or by appointment with strict observance and respect to the respective rules of its Statutes, which shall specify the procedures for regular elections and appointments.

IX. promote, in fact, through educational, social, developmental and professional actions, such as local and national competitions, besides lecture forums and symposiums

X. promote the recognition of electronic sport as a regular sport category in its national territory, with government agencies at all levels of the federal, state or municipal administration,

XI. in the creation of legislation for primarily national, state and municipal electronic sports

XII. promote public policies for electronic sport in your country and / or region and category regulation at national or regional level

Paragraph 1. Practicing entities (clubs) participating in the First Division of the International Championship for Professional and Educational Electronic Sport, and the national leagues, when and if admitted, shall remain affiliated to WESCO only as long as they satisfy all the requirements required by it., in case of clubs, the dictates constant of the

Statutes of the respective entity national and regional administration (federations) that are affiliated.

Paragraph 2 - Failure to comply with any of the requirements mentioned in this article may lead to the loss of WESCO's affiliate quality, subject to due process of law.

Paragraph 3 - WESCO shall not recognize any organs or powers of its affiliates that have not been elected or appointed in accordance with the respective Bylaws.

Paragraph 4 - WESCO will not recognize decisions and acts originating from organs or powers that have not been elected or appointed in accordance with the Statutes of its affiliates.

Paragraph 5 - WESCO shall not admit any foreign interference or interference in the organization and operation of its affiliates and related entities.

Art.16 - WESCO is integrated by the powers mentioned in art. 20, with the cooperation of the bodies referred to in the same article, and no one may stand, be elected or hold office in any power, or any position or function, whether paid or unpaid, while serving a penalty imposed or recognized by WESCO.

Paragraph 1 - The exercise of the position of who is serving a penalty or suspension shall be interrupted during the respective term.

Paragraph 2 - Ineligible for the performance of elective functions and positions in the powers of WESCO and its affiliated Entities, even those of free appointment, the persons:

- I. convicted of a felony in a final judgment ;
- II. defaulters in rendering accounts of public resources in a final administrative decision ;
- III. delinquent in providing the accounts own entity;
- IV. apart positions elected or of trust sporting entity in virtue of management equity or proven irregular financial or reckless of the same entity;
- V- defaulters, proven, as to their social security and labor contributions ;
- VI- bankrupt.
- VII- blood or related relatives, up to the second degree or by affinity, of the President or top manager, unless proven unenforceable for a particular position

Article 17 - Only citizens over 18 (eighteen) years old may occupy positions in any WESCO power or body.

Sole Paragraph - The administrators and members of the Supervisory Board of the sports entities are prohibited from exercising any other position or function in WESCO.

Art .18 - The members of the various powers and bodies of WESCO may be paid by the positions or functions that it exercise, regardless of whether, or not, link employment as a way to ensure professional management in WESCO.

Sole Paragraph - It is incumbent upon the President of WESCO to determine the amount of the compensation provided for in the caput of this article.

Art .19 - The member of any power or agency may graduate from the exercise of the position or function, for a period not exceeding 180 (one hundred eighty) days consecutive.

CHAPTER V

POWERS AND ORGANS

Article 20 - WESCO's powers are:

- I.** General Assembly ;
- II.** Fiscal Council ;
- III.** Presidency (Administration)
- IV.** General Secretariat ;
- V.** Board of Directors.
- VI.** Athlete Advice

Paragraph one - are organs auxiliary and cooperation the Council Advisory, the Council Technical, the Commission Arbitration, the Commission of Control Doping, the Committee resolution of disputes, the Ombudsman 's Sport Electronic, the Commission International of Clubs, the Commission Ethics and the Committee of Governance and Corporate Compliance, provided the creation of commissions or committees by act of the Presidency always that necessary.

Article 21 - The members of WESCO's Powers and Organs are not personally responsible for the obligations contracted in its name, in the exercise of their duties.

SECTION I Of the General Assembly

Art. 22 - The General Assembly is the basic power and of maximum jurisdiction of WESCO, where each associate and affiliated entity will have the right to 1 (one) vote, provided that it meets the norms and the requirements of these Bylaws, ensuring, also, the representativeness of the athlete category by means of the athletes committee, with the affiliate having the vote with weight 1 and the athlete commission the vote as provided in these statutes.

Paragraph 1. The General Assembly, of an administrative nature, with the exclusive participation of the directly affiliated national and regional administration entities (Federations), shall meet:

I. Ordinarily, once a year, until the last business day of April of each year, to appraise and judge the accounts for the previous year, and it is incumbent upon it to take the resolutions provided for by law and these Bylaws;

II. extraordinarily, whenever that the interests of WESCO, this Statute or the law in force require.

Paragraph 2 - The judgment of the accounts of each year shall be made in view of the financial and balance sheet, duly instructed with the opinion of the Fiscal Council, after the respective financial statements, prepared in the legal form, and may have been audited by independent auditors. .

Paragraph 3 - The General Meeting, of an administrative nature, also has exclusive competence to:

I. authorize the President of WESCO to sell real estate;

II. to award titles of Patron, President of Honor, Meritorious and the "Online Commendation", by proposal of the Presidency or by nomination of at least 2/3 (two thirds) of affiliates;

III. delegate special powers to the President of WESCO, when necessary, to practice the acts excluded from their competence explicit;

IV.- decide on the disqualification of WESCO from international sports organizations, requiring for approval the vote of 3/4 (three quarters) of all its members;

V. - interpret this Statute in last instance and fill in the relevant text omissions or gaps that by another form not remedied by requiring the most absolute for decision on the matter;

VI. - amend these Bylaws, by its own initiative or by proposal of the Presidency, being required the concurring vote of 2/3 (two thirds) of the present to the Assembly specially called for this purpose, being Ordinary or Extraordinary, and it cannot deliberate, in first call, without the presence of the absolute majority of the direct affiliates (Federations), or, in the following summons, with less than 1/3 (one third) of the present affiliates;

VII. - decide on appeal, by the disaffiliation or exclusion of being affiliated admissible only if there is just cause, complying with the provisions of this Statute; and this omission may also occur imposition of penalty if it is recognized the existence of serious reasons, in reasoned decision, by two thirds (2/3) of the present to the Shareholders' Meeting specially convened for this purpose and approved by this Assembly president WESCO ;

VIII. - Appoint and dismiss the members of the Legislative Council and when there is such a body;

IX. decide on the admission of direct affiliates and membership of national leagues;

X. resolve on the change of registered office or the dissolution of WESCO, by its own initiative or at the proposal of the Presidency, by requiring for approval

the unanimity of votes of entities affiliated direct (federations) gathered at the General Meeting or extraordinary, specially convened for this and, in the event of dissolution, the remainder of the shareholders' equity will be apportioned in compliance with the relevant legal rules .

Paragraph 4 - The General Assembly of electoral nature, it shall meet, five on five (5) years, in twelve (12) months immediately preceding the end of the mandate in progress to elect, by secret ballot, the President and the two (2) International Vice-Presidents of WESCO, administrators who constitute the Presidency, in addition to the sitting and alternate members of the Fiscal Council, who will be sworn in by the Ordinary General Meeting, and may also be online the Meeting and the vote, which may be performing subsequent to termination of the term in progress, being the precinct consists exclusively by:

I. direct affiliates or just acknowledge the decision of the Board accepting which are the national and regional governing bodies (Federations);

II. special and affiliated transitory, which are the entities practice of sport electronic (clubs) who in time of elections election are integrating the First Division of the International League of Electronic Sports, except impeachment, statutory or regulatory

III. athlete's representative.

Paragraph 5 - The decisions involving matters alluded to in item I of Paragraph 1 and in Paragraph 4 of this article require the most simple of the present to the Assembly convened for those purposes, not can it decide, in first call, without the presence of at least , one third (1/3) of the total number of entities eligible to vote, and, in the following calls , with any number.

Paragraph 6 - It is also exclusively the General Assembly that gathers direct and special affiliates, always in secret ballot, to remove the members of

the Presidency (President and the 2 (two) Vice-Presidents of WESCO), having proven just cause and observing the due process of law.

Paragraph 7 - For the resolution referred to in Paragraph 6, a minimum quorum of 3/4 (three quarters) of all direct and special affiliated entities is required, requiring for approval at least 9/10. (nine tenths) of the votes present at the Meeting exclusively called for such purpose.

Paragraph 8. The General Assembly shall be convened with the attendance of at least half and one of the affiliated entities, on first call, but may meet on the same day, one hour later, on second call, to deliberate. with any number, unless otherwise required by law or a statutory special quorum.

Paragraph 9 - The standard general of the paragraph above not be applicable to decisions in which is required, in these Bylaws, the participation of one distinct number of voters.

Paragraph 10 - To the President of WESCO, or his authorized representative, fulfills the opening of each meeting of the Assembly, which then appoint one of its members to assume the presidency, fitting to this the choice of one member of the plenary to function as Secretary of the table.

Paragraph 11 - The Assemblies General shall be convened by the President of WESCO, or, in his absence, by his deputy cool, being guaranteed to 1/5 (one fifth) of entities affiliated the right to promote the calling; in this latter case the General Assembly only decide on matters that any given cause to call for vote of that involved at least two thirds (2/3) of the affiliated.

Paragraph 12 - The General Meetings shall be called by any means that guarantees the knowledge of the summoned or by means of a notice published, once, in a large circulation newspaper of the place of WESCO headquarters, at least 8 (eight) days in advance. In case of urgency, such notice period shall be reduced to 5 (five) days.

Paragraph 13 - The General Meetings nature election shall compulsorily be convened by notice published for three (3) times in newspaper of general circulation in the city where is located the headquarters of WESCO or electronic site.

Paragraph 14 - The summons shall state, in precise terms, the date, time and place of the General Meeting, specifying necessarily the issues that should be treated as well as the registration deadlines for applications or plates, when applicable.

Paragraph 15 - The General Assembly may not deliberate on matters foreign to the Agenda, unless the unanimous resolution of the affiliated entities.

Paragraph 16 - At General Meetings, affiliates shall be represented by their respective Presidents or, in their absence, by a proxy or by one of the members of their Powers, provided that they are duly accredited by the President.

Paragraph 17 - The summary of the work of each General Assembly shall be recorded in the minutes drawn up by the Secretary appointed by the Chairman of the meeting, which may be drawn up in summary form .

Paragraph 18 - The General Assembly shall delegate powers to two (2) of its members present at the meeting to, on its behalf, confer and approve the minutes, which, to produce the legal effects , shall be signed by the Chairman of the session and the Secretary.

Paragraph 19 At the General Assembly of an electoral nature , the Chairman of the meeting shall appoint two (2) other members present to act as supervising scrutineers.

Paragraph 20 - The General Meetings shall be held without the presence of strangers, and may be attended by sports authorities, guests and members of WESCO's powers and organs.

Paragraph 21 - At General Electoral Assemblies the counting of votes may be accompanied by candidates and representatives of the media.

Paragraph 22 - The President of WESCO is assured the right to speak at General Meetings.

Paragraph 23 - For discussion of the matters contained in the Agenda, each affiliated entity shall have 5 minutes, renewable for a further 5, at the discretion of the President.

Paragraph 24 - After discussion, a vote will be taken.

Paragraph 25 - Voting shall be symbolic, except in cases where another type of voting is expressly provided for.

Paragraph 26 - A nominative vote shall be permitted at the request of at least 1/4 (one quarter) of the members present at the General Assembly, and the vote shall be by secret ballot only, using ballots in which the members shall indicate the your agreement or disagreement with the matter being voted.

Paragraph 27 - The President may warn and deny the word of the representative of the affiliated entity that:

- I. deviate from the subject that motivated the convening of the General Meeting ;
- II. exceed the statutory time allowed ;
- III. use language incompatible with the decorum of the General Assembly ;
- IV. failure to respect the principles of mutual personal consideration and those indispensable to the proper order of business.

Article 23 - At the General Assembly of an electoral nature, only candidates for the positions of President and Vice-Presidents whose plates were previously registered with WESCO may be voted.

Paragraph 1 - Mandatory registration anticipated of applications or plates must be made no later than five (5) days before the date set for the completion of the General Assembly elective.

Paragraph 2 The presentation of the candidature for the position of president or top manager of the entity with support requirement limited to a maximum of 5% (five percent) of the electoral college;

Paragraph 3 - Only the sheet that will be recorded is presented and endorsed, both the minimum of four (4) Federations affiliated direct and 3 (three) bodies of practice esports special transitional affiliates in the full enjoyment of their statutory rights .

Paragraph 4 - No entity directly affiliated or special and transient may sign the request for more registration of one plate competitor to the election in WESCO.

Paragraph 5 - The application for registration of any application submitted by an affiliated entity that has already signed another petition requesting registration of a plate previously filed with WESCO shall be null and void.

Paragraph 6 - The request for registration of the plates shall be considered by the WESCO Presidency .

Paragraph 7 - There may be elected to the positions of their bodies or powers the relatives consanguineous or the like, to the second degree or affinity, the President or leader most.

Paragraph 8 - There shall be no registration of the plate for the election of the Fiscal Council.

Article 24 - The elections shall be held by secret ballot or by secret ballot online by means of specialized software or other indicated system, and in the event of a tie, a second ballot shall be held among those placed first.

Sole Paragraph - If, after further scrutiny, another tie occurs, the eldest candidate shall be deemed to be the oldest.

Art. 25 - The vote will be bound to the candidates of the same plate, being considered null the vote if any alteration is made in the ballot.

Art . 26 - It will be considered void the vote if the entity affiliated to put in more envelope one ballot or if use of another ballot not be one of those previously initialed, received the table.

Article 27 - At the time of voting in the elections, upon being called, the representative of the affiliated entity shall receive from the table an envelope and as many ballots as the registered plates , all duly initialed by the tellers.

Paragraph 1 - In possession of the envelope and the respective ballots, the representative of the affiliated entity, in an undeniable place, will place one of the ballots in the envelope, then closing it.

Paragraph 2 - In the act of depositing the envelope in the ballot box, the representative of the voting affiliated entity shall display it to the tellers, so that they can see the rubrics and verify that it is the same that was handed to them.

Art . 28 - After the vote, the tellers shall count total of the votes cast in the ballot box, to which should match the number total of envelopes distributed.

Sole Paragraph - After the conference, the tellers will proceed to the opening of the envelopes and counting of the votes.

Art. 29 - After the investigation the President 's table proclaim the results.

Article 30 - Electoral processes shall ensure:

I. electoral college constituted, under the terms of this Statute, of all direct and special affiliated entities, in the enjoyment of their rights;

II. prior defense, in case of challenge to the right to participate in the election;

III. system gathering the votes immune to fraud;

IV. electoral college made up of all affiliates in the enjoyment of their rights, observing that the category of athlete must have the equivalent of at least 1/3 (one third) of the votes, already computed the eventual differentiation of value that deals with the item I caput of art. 22 of Brazilian Law of Sports 9,615 / 1998, main headquarter of WESCO.

V. Possibility of applying for the position of president or top manager of the entity with support requirement limited to a maximum of five percent (5%) of the electoral college;

VI. prior publication of the calendar of meetings of the general meeting and subsequent sequential publication of minutes of meetings held during the year; and

VII. Participation of athletes in the governing boards and electoral college through representatives of athletes elected directly and independently by the affiliated athletes of the entity.

SECTION II

From the Fiscal Council

Art. 31 - The Council Tax, the power of supervision of the administration financial of WESCO, consists of 3 (three) members and 3 (three) substitutes, elected by the General Assembly Elective, to mandate 4 (four) years.

Paragraph 1 - There may be elected to the Council Tax the employees of WESCO and the relatives up to the third degree, the members of the Presidency and Board.

Paragraph 2 - The Fiscal Council, which shall prepare and approve its Internal Regulations, shall function with the presence of the majority of its members, and shall, at the first meeting, elect its Chairman.

Paragraph 3 - It will be up to the President of the Council Tax designate an alternate who will replace the member effective in cases of license, impediment or vacancy of the post.

Paragraph 4 - When Council Tax shall in addition to the provisions in the current legislation, and in accordance with its Bylaws, the following:

I. examine at any time the books, documents and balance sheets;

II. plowing look referring to the result of examination conducted in the form of section I of this paragraph

III. submit to the General Assembly an annual opinion on the motion economic, financial and administrative of WESCO, consolidated in the balance sheet General statements and financial;

IV. to report to the General Assembly any administrative errors or any violation of the law or these By-Laws, suggesting the measures to be taken, including so that, in each case, it may fully exercise its supervisory function;

V. meet, when necessary, upon the convening of its Chairman, 1/3 (one third) of the members of the General Assembly or the Chairman of WESCO.

VI. supervise the accounting procedures of the independent external audit ;

VII. give an opinion, when requested by the Chairman of WESCO or the General Meeting, on any matter concerning WESCO's financial management.

Paragraph 5 - The effective members of the Fiscal Council shall choose among themselves, a Rapporteur of the matter under examination or submitted to the body, the remaining two acting as members.

SECTION III

From the Presidency (Administration)

Art . 32 - The Presidency of WESCO, made by the President and the two (2) Vice-Presidents who are the their elected directors by the Electoral General Assembly, is the power that exercises administrative and functions executive of the authority, assisted by the Secretary General and by the Board.

Article 33 - The Chairman's term of office is five (5) years, with multiple reelections allowed, and shall begin at the end of the General Meeting that occurs subsequent to the election, with the purpose of examining and judging the accounts for the previous financial year.

Paragraph 1 - The position of Vice President is not subject to the restriction of the caption of this article .

Paragraph 2 - The election, for any position or function, is forbidden to the spouse and consanguineous or related relatives, up to the 2nd degree or by affinity of the President or Chief Executive Officer.

Article 34 - All members of the Presidency shall be vested in their positions upon signature of the respective terms of office, and shall remain in office until the investiture of their successors.

Art . 35 - It will replace the President in case of absence or occasional impediment, the Vice - President for that he is appointed.

Article 36 - The Vice Presidents shall assist the President whenever they are called by him for special missions .

Article 37 - If the office of President is vacant at any time during the term of office, the oldest Vice-President shall complete the period.

Sole Paragraph - In the event of vacancy in any position of Vice- President, at any time during the term of office, there shall be an election to fill it, and the President of WESCO shall convene the General Meeting of an electoral nature .

Article 38 - If vacancy occurs in all positions of the Presidency, there will be election to fill.

Art . 39 - The members of the Presidency will meet always that if you need to and are convened by the President, and the decisions of the Presidency will be adopted in any case, by the vote of the majority of its members present at the meeting, fitting the President, in the event of a tie, in addition to his vote, the casting vote .

Article 40 - Without prejudice to the powers of supervision, coordination, direction and supervision of the President, the members of the Presidency shall:

Approve all the acts that complement this Statute, Regulation General, other regulations and bylaws, as well as acts of normative character own the WESCO, except for the competence of other powers;

II. to propose to the General Assembly the total or partial amendment of these Bylaws;

III. propose to the General Assembly to grant honorary titles and medals of merit;

- IV.** propose to the General Assembly the sale of goods real estate;
- V.** propose to the General Assembly the disaffiliation of WESCO from international organizations and entities , as well as the dissolution of the entity;
- VI.** organize and approve the annual or each season calendar of national and international competitions , in compliance with international standards and subject to sports law ;
- VII.** institute the regime of classification, transfer, removal and reversal of athletes, deciding on the matter, observing the international norms and the sports legislation ;
- VIII.** approve the model of the emblem of WESCO and the uniform;
- IX.** grant license to its members and members of other powers and organs of cooperation.
- X.** appreciate the monthly balance sheets of income and expense, forwarding them to the Fiscal Council ;
- XI.** grant or deny affiliation or affiliation , after regular process , ad referendum of the General Assembly ;
- XII.** to examine the statutes of the affiliates and the respective reforms, as well as those of the entities that postulate affiliation to WESCO;
- XIII.** order the intervention in the affiliates, in the hypothesis provided for in these Bylaws;
- XIV.** to disassemble Federations, associations, leagues, clubs and teams by direct decision, and appreciated by the board with the agreement of 2/3 (of the thirds) of the directors;
- XV.** authorize the holding of competitions international and regional and international, in compliance with relevant legislation, as well as conducting competitions without the course within a minimum;
- XVI.** Judging the resources of decisions and acts of the President, since it brought in within five days from the date of the act contested;
- XVII.** Judging the resources of decisions and acts of the Council Technical;

Article 41 - The President, in addition to the other duties established in these Statutes and in sports law, is responsible for:

- I.** make decisions judged, in his understanding, timely order and the interests of WESCO, including in cases omitted;
- II.** ensure the harmony between the affiliated entities, for the benefit of progress and unity policy of international esports;
- III.** supervise, coordinate, direct and supervise WESCO's administrative, economic, financial and sports activities;
- IV.** appoint and dismiss the Secretary General of WESCO and may authorize him to exercise, to a large or limited extent, any of the express or implied attributions set forth in this article;
- V.** Oversee the work of the General Secretariat ;
- VI.** supervise staff in the entity and, as a result, nominate, admit, designate, commission, enter into or terminate contracts, dismiss, dismiss,

dismiss, punish, dismiss, license, holiday, compliment, reward, initiate inquiries and initiate proceedings;

VII. appoint and dismiss the Board members who are independent of the election, appoint advisors, assistants and the components of the commissions established;

VIII. appoint and dismiss the members of any commissions and committees created by an act of the Presidency and appoint the members of the Board Advisory indicated in the form of art. 51 of this Statute.

IX. fix the remuneration of directors, employees, advisors and members of the powers and organs of WESCO, regardless of having, or not employed by the entity;

X. submit to the General Assembly at each one of their meetings annually, report management held in the year before, along with the balance of the movement economic - financial and the opinion of the Council Tax;

XI. comply with and enforce the rules established by national and international sports organizations and entities to which WESCO is affiliated;

XII. call the powers and organs;

XIII. supervise the collection of revenues and authorize the payment of expenses;

XIV. deciding on the setting of prizes and bonuses for the participation of athletes and others involved in competitions competing for WESCO representative teams and teams ;

XV. Contribute, free of charge, to social movements of recognized repute, without discrimination of any kind.

XVI. call, without voting rights, the WESCO General Meetings;

XVII. call the Fiscal Council ;

XVIII. call and chair the meetings of the Presidency and the Board of Executive Officers, with voting rights, including quality, in the event of a tie;

XIV. to set up the delegations responsible for the representation of WESCO, inside or outside the country;

XX. sign, in conjunction with the Chief Financial Officer or, in his absence, with the Treasurer, or grant powers for the joint signature with the Chief Financial Officer or, in his absence , with the Treasurer, of securities, checks, receipts or any other documents that constitute rights or obligations.

financial, as well as all the acts that involve responsibility for the WESCO, subject to the provisions of this Statute;

XXI celebrate, together with the Director of the respective area, covenants and agreements that imply in commitments for the WESCO;

XXII. authorize the publicity of acts originating from the powers and organs; putting into execution the decision-making acts of powers, as well as the autonomous agencies of Justice Sports, effecting the penalties for them applied in the scope of their duties;

XXIII. arrange for the custody and preservation of property movable and immovable property of WESCO, constitute real rights to the property listings and alienate them, upon authorization of the General Assembly;

XXIV. deposit or determine a deposit with a reputable financial institution of WESCO securities, in cash or securities, when large;

XXV. review penalties, including relieving, amnesting or commuting them;

XXVI. apply to those legal and physical subject to the jurisdiction of WESCO, the sanctions applicable prescribed in this Statute, or in any other act of the entity, except for the power of d emails powers and Justice Sports;

XXVII. compromise, give up, grant moratorium;

XXVIII. grant amnesty of a disciplinary or pecuniary character ; issue notices to affiliates, subject to the rules of these By-Laws and the competence of the other powers;

XXIX sign, together with the Chief Financial Officer , the Treasurer or the Director of the respective area, any contract that creates an obligation or right for the entity;

XXX. sign Presidency (RDP) and Board (RDI) Resolutions ;

XXXI apply penalties provided for in these Statutes.

XXXII. grant any powers of attorney on behalf of WESCO;

XXXIII. to decide on the granting of monetary aid to affiliates and entities that practice electronic sports (clubs);

XXXIV authorize the performance of expenses, provided that resources are available.

XXXV Publish documents and information relating to accountability, as well as those related to the management of WESCO in your part of the electronic site of this .

Art .42 - The WESCO may constitute attorney for the commission of any acts, but always with a specific purpose and period of validity limited to maximum of 1 (one) year, except the attorney for purposes judicial or for defense in the process administrative, which may be granted for an indefinite period.

Art. 42a – The Presidents of Regional Vice-presidency (America, Africa, Europe, Middle-east, Oceania and Asia) and also the Presidents of Regional Advisory Board shall be pointed and destitute by any moment by the President of WESCO.

SECTION IV

From the General Secretariat

Article 43 - The General Secretariat carries out all administrative work of WESCO, under the direction of a Secretary General appointed by the President.

Article 44 - Subject to the provisions of these Statutes, the Secretary General shall:

- I. the organization of the General Secretariat ;
- II. perform the duties and activities determined by the Presidency;
- III. implement the decisions taken by the other powers of WESCO, in accordance with the direction of the President;
- IV. take charge of WESCO correspondence ;
- V. communicate with WESCO and with the other international organizations and institutions.

SECTION V

From the Board

Art. 45 - The WESCO have one Board appointed by the President and composed of, at most, 20 (twenty) members, appointed Directors, with the function to assist the Presidency, plus one member Special Representative of the athletes;

Paragraph Single - The members Special is representative s of the athletes shall be elected by vote of the athletes themselves, in a direct election organized by sports management entity together with entities representing them.

Article 46 - It is incumbent upon the President to designate and, at any time, dismiss the Directors, conferring on them the attributions and powers deemed convenient.

Article 47 - By resolution of the President, each Director may be in charge of the supervision of a sector or a set of activities, whose names the President shall define, at his discretion.

Article 48 - The members of the Board of Executive Officers may request from the President, when necessary, the hiring of specialized technical advisory services to support their activities, always with the objective of professionalizing the management of International electronic sport.

Art . 49 - The Board meeting shall be at least one time per month and whenever it becomes necessary, being convened by the President and its decisions shall be taken, in any case, by a majority vote of its members present at the meeting.

SECTION VI

From the Regional vice Presidency and Regional Advisory Board

Art. 50 - The WESCO have 6 (six) administrative regions, and 6 (six) Advisory Board for each administrative region, which will be chaired by the President, to advise the members of the Presidency and the Board on matters relevant to the achievement of its responsible, yet to rule on any matter that is submitted to its consideration by the President of WESCO.

Article 51 - The members of the Regional Presidency and Regional Advisory Board shall be appointed annually at an opportune or necessary time, and their appointment shall be formalized by act of the President of WESCO.

Article 52 - The Regional Presidency and Regional Advisory Board is composed of 6 (six) representatives chosen by the president of WESCO, who may or may not be presidents of national and regional entities (Federations). The regional vice presidents, are those that represent the five (6) regions geographical the Americas, concept that is also used for purposes of participation of entities from practice of sport electronic (Clubs) in competitions:

- I. America
- II. Europe;
- III. Asia;
- VI. Africa;
- V. Middle-east; and
- VI. Oceania

Art .53 - The Advisory Board will meet whenever it is convened by the President of WESCO or on the initiative, at least 2/3 (two thirds) of its members, by any means, with the least of 3 (three) days.

SECTION VII From the Technical Council

Article 54 -. The Council Technician will be composed by the entities practice of electronic sports (clubs), members and disputants competitions coordinated by WESCO, and the category of athletes, in compliance with the number of participants set by WESCO.

Paragraph 1 - At the end of each International Electronic Sport Championship , it is incumbent upon the President of WESCO to download an act with indication and appointment of the entities of sports practice that are members of the respective divisions for the subsequent sporting year , following exclusively the technical criteria.

Paragraph 2 - The category of athletes and the practice entities will be guaranteed representation within the technical bodies and councils with competence for approval of competition regulations organized by the entity.

Art. 55 - The Board Technical chaired by the President of WESCO, or by who is for it indicated, shall be convened by the President or at the request of 1/3 (one third) of the respective components, by any means, with the advance minimum of 3 (three) days.

Article 56 - The Technical Council shall be responsible for deliberating on the Specific Competition Regulation (REC) and approving matters relating to the form and system of competition dispute, as well as its regulation, as well as

on the pricing of tickets, aiming primarily at improving the technical quality of the competition, in compliance with the legal provisions and the annual calendar of International electronic sport established by WESCO.

Art . 57 - Subject to the provisions in the Regulation of Competition, the national and regional authority administration where the game is done it is removing income from its starting expenses and the amounts corresponding to the payment of staff arbitration always that it is competition national , as well as discounting the taxes and social charges due, collecting them, within the legal deadline , to the public collecting entities , immediately sending the respective evidences to WESCO.

Article 58 - The decisions of the Technical Council shall obey the principle of qualitative voting by technical classification and shall be taken by a simple majority vote of the sports entities , requiring the presence of two (2/3) of the contestants at the first meeting. summoned and any number at the second meeting.

Art. 59 - The entities of practice of electronic sport that are members of the Technical Council will have, in each season that they participate, transiently and annually, a number of votes of technical nature , equal and inversely proportional to their classification, obtained in the last International Sport Championship. Electronic Professional completed in the respective Division, so that the last placed, whether or not coming from access, will have a vote; the penultimate, two votes, and so forth until the first placed, which will have the same number of votes of how many are the disputants of the respective Division.

Art . 60 - After its approval, the Regulation Specific Competition (REC) will be available in the WESCO site, can that regulation be amended by decision unanimously of its members, in accordance with the legislation in force and complied with the provisions of the General Regulations of Competitions (RGC).

Article 61 - Any other divisions of the International Championship shall each have a specific Technical Council, the operation of which shall obey the rules contained in this Section.

SECTION VIII

From the Arbitration Commission

Article 62 - WESCO will have an Arbitration Committee, which will, in particular:

- I. verify, within the scope of their activities, the faithful compliance with the laws of the game;
- II. promote the training of referees, assistant referees , inspectors and referees instructors / trainers ;
- III. make the squad of referees and their assistants for the matches of competitions national, the which may be chosen by lot among those previously selected; organize the exams theoretical and practical aptitude for the referees.

Sole Paragraph - The rules and recommendations issued by the Arbitration Committee shall be submitted to the Presidency for the purpose of issuing the normative acts, and the observance of all WESCO guidelines and guidelines regarding arbitration shall be cogent.

Article 63 - The Arbitration Committee is composed of up to 7 (seven) members, appointed by the President of WESCO, who among them, shall appoint the President and the Vice-President, and its organization and operation shall be established in its own regulation, approved by the Presidency of WESCO.

Paragraph one - not may integrate the Arbitration Commission to that exercise position or function, paid or not, in the national and regional authorities of management and / or entities practice of sport electronic which they are affiliated.

SECTION IX

From the Doping Control Commission

Art. 64 - WESCO will have a Doping Control Commission, called by DEPADO (Anti-Doping Department) consisting of up to 7 (seven) members, appointed by the WESCO President, who among them, will appoint the President and Vice-President, and shall its organization and operation shall be established in its own regulations, approved by the WESCO Presidency.

Paragraph one - not may integrate the Commission of Control Doping those who exercise position or function, paid or not, the entities national and regional administration and / or practice of sport entities electronic to them affiliated.

Art. 65 - It will be up to the Doping Control Commission to take the necessary measures to prevent, to combat the repression and control doping in international electronic sport, subject to national regulations and international.

SECTION X

From the Dispute Resolution Committee

Art. 66 - WESCO will have in its recognition the CARLEE - Electronic Sports Dispute Resolution Chamber, a Dispute Resolution Committee consisting of up to 5 (five) members, appointed by the President of WESCO, who among them will appoint the President and Vice-President, should its organization and operation be established in own regulations, approved by the Presidency of WESCO.

Article 67 -. The CARLEE has the jurisdiction to decide any dispute between one player or one entity of sports and one agent players, or between two or more agents of registered players in WESCO. Can the WESCO charge of litigants reasonable values to comply to that regarding the features Regulation of agents Players, the WESCO.

SECTION XI

From the Electronic Sport Ombudsman

Article 68 - Each International competition will have an Ombudsman, freely appointed by the President of WESCO, responsible for collecting the suggestions, claims and complaints of the fans, evaluating and seeking solutions to the problems raised, as well as suggesting measures necessary for the improvement and transparency of the competition. competition and the benefit of the fan.

Paragraph one - The WESCO provide one site on the internet to use the Ombudsman of each competition which will be published, so open and objective, information, demonstrations and proposals, such as ensuring the right to information of citizens and shape public dialog with the fan .

SECTION XII

Of the International Esports Clubs/Teams Commission

Art . 68 -

WESCO will, in character standing, one Commission International of teams tasked to make suggestions in order to ensure the balance competitive, the modernization organizational and integrity of the competitions national of sport electronic.

Sole Paragraph - The International Club Commission shall be composed each season by nine (9) members, chosen by their peers, namely:

- I- five (5) representatives of First Division clubs (Series A);
- II- two (2) representatives of the clubs of the Second Division (Series B);
- III- one (1) representative of the clubs of the Third Division (Series C);
- IV- one (1) representative of the clubs of the Fourth Division (Series D)

SECTION XIII

Ethics Committee

Article 68 - B - WESCO's Ethics Committee shall be composed of three autonomous and independent members of the Board of Directors, of unblemished reputation and notorious knowledge, to be appointed by act of the Presidency.

Paragraph one - The Commission of Ethics WESCO may punish leaders, athletes, referees, members of commissions techniques, intermediaries and organizers matches esports of applying any of the penalties that are provided in

this Statute, requiring one minimum of three members to adopt any decision, subject to the jurisdiction of the Sports Justice .

SECTION XIV

From the Corporate Governance and Compliance Committee

Art . 68 - C - The Committee of Governance and Corporate Compliance WESCO will be composed by three members autonomous and independent of the Board, of unblemished reputation and notorious specialization, to be appointed by act of the Presidency, the which should seek excellence in Corporate Governance and Compliance, with a view to strengthening and creating the best conditions for the development of International electronic sport , based on four basic principles :

I. Transparency / Disclosure - communication
process quick and spontaneous with the public internal and external, contemplating the factors that guide the action management of WESCO aiming to sedimentation of integrity and values credibility;

II. Equity / Fairness -
treatment fair and equitable for all the parties concerned, such as players, managers, coaches, referees, fans, customers, suppliers, agencies government, employees, lenders, etc .;

III. Accountability / Accountability - accountability of managers to
all the entities affiliated to WESCO and responsibility for the acts that practice in the exercise of their mandates;

IV. Responsibility Corporate /
Compliance- zeal for sustainability and continuity of the international sport electronic, preventing the risks and distortions in sectors, activities, processes and people most vulnerable in the organization, together with the observance of the legislation in force

CHAPTER VI

SPORT JUSTICE AND ORGANS

SECTION I

SPORTS JUSTICE

Art . 69 - The Justice Sport is responsible for prosecuting and judging matters relating to breach of rules regarding the discipline and the competition sports.

Article 70 - The Sports Justice of Electronic Sport, whose organs are endowed with capacity and legitimacy, as provided for in art. 217, Paragraph 1 and Paragraph 2º of the Federal Constitution, is divided into autonomous and independent units , namely

I. Superior Court of Sports Justice (STJD);

II. Disciplinary Committees (CD).

Paragraph 1 - The Auditors components Sport STJD the Electronic shall be appointed by the entities and representative segments provided in the legislation sporty federal, by letter addressed to the President of WESCO, to whom compete the formal appointment of the nominees, by Ordinance, which will be forwarded to STJD to subsequent sitting at the Court.

Paragraph 2 - The following may not be part of any of the Sports Justice organs of electronic sport:

- I. the leaders of WESCO, elected or appointed;
- II. the elected or appointed leaders of the affiliated federations ;
- III. the leaders, elected or appointed, the entities sporting disputants practice competitions of professional esports, except the members of the Councils Deliberative;
- IV. the referees or assistants of arbitration that are acting in playing sports official electronic;
- V. the athletes registered and who are vying esports competitions;
- VI. people prevented or prohibited by law, as well as the occupants of positions or functions, public or private, considered incompatible to act as auditor or attorney in your sports judicantes organs.

Paragraph 3 - The autonomy and independence of which enjoy these units Justice Sport not the waiver of the obligation to comply with the statutes, regulations, circulars and decisions and Code of Ethics of WESCO, not the exempt the duty to respect the principles and standards of the Code discipline of WESCO, application universal, and the International Code of Justice Sports (CBJD) of application International.

Paragraph 4 - The autonomy and independence guaranteed, by law, to the Sports Justice organs, entail for the Auditors, their components, exclusive responsibility for the acts that they perform in the exercise of their functions, not responding to WESCO, in any way, for the acts. practiced by the sports judging bodies of electronic sport.

Article 71 - The Electronic Sports Sports Justice bodies shall have the composition, organization, administration, operation and competence as set forth in their Internal Regulations drawn up in strict compliance with sports law, especially the International Code of Sports Justice (CBJD).

Article 72 - Costs for the operation of the Sports Justice bodies are subject to the following rules:

- I. presentation, with the required advance, the periodicity established by the Bank of budget expenses necessary for the functioning of the organs Sports Justice, getting the payments conditioned always to the prior mandatory approval of the Presidency of the Entity;
- II. only they are authorized new spending, after the mandatory accountability forwarded by the President of the

STJD, educated with all the documents supporting and reputable spending actually occurred.

SECTION II

THE ARBITRATION COURT

Article 73 - WESCO shall establish an arbitral tribunal to settle domestic disputes between itself, its members, the clubs, the players, the referees, the coaches, the doctors, the fitness coaches, the assistants, the match officials and the players' agents in matters that fall outside the jurisdiction of the Sports Justice.

Sole Paragraph - It shall be incumbent upon WESCO's Presidency to elaborate the rules of this Arbitration Tribunal, especially regarding its composition, jurisdiction and procedures.

Article 74 - WESCO, its members, clubs, players, referees, coaches, doctors, fitness coaches, assistants, match agents and players agents shall not take their disputes to the ordinary courts except in the events established in these By-Laws and in the WESCO regulations. Any disagreement will be subject to the jurisdiction of WESCO or WESCO.

Sole Paragraph - WESCO shall be the competent jurisdiction to resolve domestic domestic disputes, ie disputes between parties or related to WESCO, while WESCO shall be the competent jurisdiction of international disputes, ie claims between parties of separate national associations or Confederations.

Art.75 - The WESCO ensure the fulfillment full and compliance by part of clubs, players, referees, coaches, doctors, trainers, assistants, matches agents and players' agents in any final decision adopted by organ of WESCO.

CHAPTER VII

RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF ASSOCIATED AFFILIATES

SECTION I

Rights

Article 76 - The rights of affiliated and associated national and regional administrations (Federations) are:

I. **to** **be** governed by its own internal laws , respecting the sports legislation and the order of superior hierarchy ;

II. represent themselves by discussing and / or voting at the General Meetings, in accordance with the Bylaws;

III. dispute the championships and tournaments coordinated by WESCO, in accordance with the respective regulations;

IV. contest the validity of the competition result, request

V. reconsideration or appeal against acts that it deems detrimental to its interests and those of its affiliates, in compliance with legal and regulatory rules;

VI. request the forwarding of hours to organizations or entities International, fenced address it directly without prior correspondence science of WESCO;

VII. accreditation, where appropriate, representative at WESCO, with representative powers, being responsible for all the their acts;

VIII. It is recognized by WESCO as single entity management and direction of the electronic sport in their country and / or region, bringing together all the entities state administration of his country, or nationals from their region of esports not professional, and also all the entities of sports practice (clubs) practitioners of professional electronic sport based in the territory under their jurisdiction;

IX. Having the guarantee to unrestricted access to all the partners and affiliates to documents and information relating to accountability, as well as those related to the management of WESCO, the which shall be published in part in the electronic site of this.

X. all the other rights that result hereof or which are recognized by the regulations and other acts of WESCO.

SECTION II

Duties

Article 77 - The duties of affiliated and associated national and regional administrations (Federations) are:

I. At all times observe WESCO's Articles of Association, regulations, guidelines and decisions, ensuring that these rules are respected by its members.

II. maintain sporting relationships with the other national and regional affiliates of administration (federations);

III. comply with and enforce the provisions of these Bylaws and other acts and rules of WESCO, determinations issued by it and the standards issued by the international entities to which WESCO owes compliance;

IV. apply for authorization to promote national, international and regional competitions;

V. to provide WESCO, as soon as possible, with any requested information, observing the deadlines, when established;

VI. arrange for that attend the WESCO or the place for this appointed, when legally summoned, its leaders, athletes and any individual who is under their jurisdiction;

VII. play all the championships and tournaments coordinated by WESCO, with character required, or in which is enrolled until their final participation in the form of regulations related;

VIII. refer, for knowledge of WESCO, annually logo that approved the calendar sports, the competitions regulations and their tables;

IX. meet, the times themselves, the obligations with the WESCO;

X. meet and do with that their affiliates comply with the annual calendar of sport electronic International approved by WESCO with strict and cogent observance of periods and dates set for the completion of international, regional and national competitions of esports professional;

XI. observe and respect the rules set approved by WESCO;

XII. not maintain relationship character sports with entities international esports not recognized as partners or by WESCO, as well as with organizations and clubs suspended or excluded;

XIII. adopt clause statutory in which be specified that any dispute or litigation that requires arbitration and is related with the Statutes, regulations, directives and provisions of WESCO and ultimately of WESCO, or the federations affiliated and that involve the Federation itself affiliated or the one of its members will be subject exclusively to the jurisdiction of the court of arbitration WESCO and last instances of WESCO, prohibited any appeal against the courts ordinary;

XIV. fulfill any other obligation that result hereof or of regulations and other acts of WESCO.

XV. Respect the position and person of the President of WESCO in such a way that it will never denigrate, doubt or even point out any actions that have not been previously judged by the Legal proceedings described in these Bylaws in Section IV - Article 11a.

XVI. Submit when required and within the stated time, without dispute, any necessary documents, and other general or specific explanations of matters and matters that may be listed by the WESCO Presidency or Board of Executive Officers, and such submission shall be made to the WESCO Board and Presidency, and non-compliance may consequently have for the Federation, League, Team or Organization the sanctions provided

Article 78 - WESCO, for the purpose of participating in the competitions coordinated by it, shall preferentially recognize the titles and classifications obtained by the professional and educational electronic sports entities (clubs) in the official championships promoted by the respective management entities (Federations).

Art. 79 - The entities of practice of the electronic sport (clubs) that, by free option or granting license, cease to participate in the Regional or Continental Championship of Professional Electronic Sport of the Main Division of the respective Region and Continental and will be immediately and automatically downgraded to the lower division in their country, and barred from participating in any competition coordinated by WESCO, as well as in official or international and friendly matches, except with exceptional conduct and permission or by granting presidential pardon.

CHAPTER VIII

ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL SCHEME

SECTION I

Financial Year

Article 80 - The fiscal year shall coincide with the calendar year and the respective statements (General Balance Sheet), after being audited by independent auditors, shall be submitted, together with the Fiscal Council's opinion, to the General Meeting, for deliberation, and, if applicable. the case, final approval

Sole Paragraph - The financial statements shall be prepared and published in accordance with the law.

Article 81 - WESCO's sources of appeal include:

I. the rents or quotas earned on matches played by any selections organized by the entity;

II. awards received;

III. income from tournaments, competitions, championships or events;

IV. revenues from sponsorship and the sale of rights;

V. revenue arising from the assignment of rights;

VI. the income derived from the investment of its assets property and the exploitation of the name of WESCO and its symbols;

VII. the income resulting from transmission contracts and relay images of events and competitions esports with the participation of teams Brazil, as well as contracts sponsorship and licensing by WESCO;

VIII. miscellaneous fees ;

IX. the product of fines and indemnities;

X. donations or legacies converted into cash;

XI. any other monetary resources that the Presidency may create;

XII. any incomes .

Article 82 - WESCO's expenses include:

I. the cost of sports
activities, miscellaneous charges and the administration and professional management of WESCO;

II. the taxes federal, national and regional and municipal;

III. advertising expenses ;

IV. representation expenses ;

V. obligations of payment that becomes
due in consequence of decisions legal, agreements, contracts and operations of credit;

VI. the charges cash of character extraordinary;

VII. other expenses related to the their purposes.

Paragraph one - No expense will be processed without which the respective payment subject to the authorization of the President of WESCO or the Secretary General, this when properly equipped with such powers, granted by the President.

SECTION II

Heritage

Article 83 - WESCO's assets include:

- I-** movable and immovable property acquired under any title;
- II-** trophies and prizes that are not susceptible to alienation;
- III-** donations and legacies;
- IV-** any other rights and values.

Article 84 - Real estate may not be sold by the Presidency without approval of the General Meeting.

SECTION III

Financial Management Standards

Article 85 - The constitutive elements of the economic and financial order shall be recorded in the proper books and evidenced by documents kept on file, observing the provisions of public legislation, especially the tax and social security legislation.

Paragraph 1 - The accounting services shall be performed under conditions that allow the immediate knowledge of the position of the accounts related to equity and finances.

Paragraph 2 - All income and expenses are subject to proof of payment or payment and the statement of the respective balances.

Paragraph 3 - The general balance sheet of each year, which will discriminate the results of the balance sheet and financial accounts, shall be prepared as defined by law and published in the Official Gazette, until the last business day of April, after being audited by independent auditors. .

CHAPTER IX

HONORIFIC TITLES

Article 86 - The General Assembly, by proposal of the Presidency, or by appointment of at least 2/3 (two thirds) of members, may grant the title of Patron, President of Honor and Meritorious, to whom has provided relevant services to WESCO, the electronic sport or the sport.

Article 87 - The titles, medals and diplomas granted by WESCO grant the recipients rights to a special card that will give them free entry to competitions organized by the affiliated entities.

CHAPTER X

SPORT ORDER

Article 88 - WESCO, within the scope of its attributions, has the power to decide, by letter, or when submitted to them by the interested party, the questions related to the compliance with the norms and rules of sports practice.

Paragraph 1. In order to maintain sports order and respect for acts emanating from its internal powers, the following sanctions may be applied to its affiliates by WESCO:

- I. warning;
- II. suspension;
- III. disaffiliation or disengagement.

Paragraph 2 - The application of the sanctions provided for in Paragraph 1 does not dispense with the administrative process in which the adversarial and the broad defense are ensured.

Paragraph 3 - The penalties referred to in items I and III of Paragraph 1 of this article shall only be applied after the final decision of the Board of Directors and the Presidency of WESCO.

Paragraph 4 - The survey administration will be held by the board of WESCO, with the period of 15 (fifteen) days to its conclusion.

Paragraph 5 - The inquiry, after its conclusion, shall be sent to the President, who shall submit it for consideration.

Paragraph 6 - Except for the cases of appeals, the administrative penalties applied by Power competent of WESCO only may be switched or anistiadadas by own power to the applied.

Art. 89 - WESCO will not intervene in its affiliates, except to put an end to serious cases that may compromise the respect to the internal powers or to restore the sports order in electronic sport, always observing the due process of law.

Article 90 -. In cases of urgency proven, and character preventive, the competent organ of the entity shall decide on the withdrawal of any individual or entity to it directly or indirectly linked, infringes or tolerates that are breaching the rules contained in this Statute WESCO or even the Statute of WESCO, as well as the rules contained in the legislation sport and the regulations WESCO.

CHAPTER XI

DISSOLUTION

Art. 91- The dissolution of WESCO only may be approved by unanimity of votes of entities affiliated associates gathered in General Meeting specially convened for this purpose.

Article 92 - In the event of WESCO's dissolution, the remainder of its shareholders' equity will have the destination provided for by law.

CHAPTER XII

GENERAL AND TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS

Art 93 -. Except for the rights of entities sport of the WESCO and affiliated federations are owners of all the rights that emanate from the competitions and other acts performed in their jurisdiction, without any kind of restriction as to content, time, place and other technical and legal aspects . These rights include, but are not limited to, all types of financial rights, audiovisual and radio recordings , reproduction and transmission rights, multimedia rights , market- technical and promotional rights, as well as intangible rights such as badges and all other rights. of intellectual property rights.

Paragraph one - The WESCO and federations affiliated has the sole responsibility for authorizing the distribution of images, sounds and other data matches sports electronic or futsal and other acts performed in their jurisdiction, without any type of restriction with respect to content, time, place and other technical aspects and legal, except the rights of entities practice of sports

Article 94 - The publicity of WESCO acts and resolutions shall be made public through the Internet on its official website.

Article 95 - The members of WESCO's powers and organs, as well as the presidents of the affiliated and associated entities , bearers of identification cards issued by it , shall have free access in all sports squares where electronic sports matches are being held, should be reserved for them seat in sector referred especially to the authorities.

Article 96. Athletes are entitled to representation at General Meetings. The duly constituted representative shall have the right to voice and one vote, as well as to apply for management positions of the Entity, pursuant to art. 18a (g) of Law 9.615 / 1998.

Paragraph 1 It is also guaranteed the participation of athletes, by duly constituted representative, in the Organs and / or Technical Councils responsible for the approval of the regulations of the competitions organized by this one, as well as the guarantee of the representation of the category of athletes in the governing bodies and in the election for the athletes. positions of the entity.

Paragraph 2 The representation provided for in Paragraph 1 of this article is unpaid and will be linked to the Board of Sports, with voice and vote for prior approval of the regulations and calendar of competitions.

Paragraph 3 The organization will organize an election in conjunction with the entities representing the athletes, in which active enrolled athletes, will elect by vote their representative, who should hear, whenever possible, the largest number of athletes and will be regulated in Internal Rules.

Article 97 - The participation of the national and regional administration entities (Federations), affiliated to WESCO, in the International, professional and non-professional championships, in the various categories, shall be mandatory .

Article 98. WESCO recognizes and maintains the honorary titles previously granted, as well as the "Online Commendation".

Art . 99 - are associated and affiliated to WESCO national and regional entities of esports administration (federations) that meet technical and administrative requirements laid out in Statutes t o.

Art. 100 - The entities of practice of the electronic sport (clubs), participants of any competitions coordinated by WESCO, will be automatically replaced, at the end of each competition, due to the application of the technical criteria established in the respective Regulations, respecting the provisions of the RGC. from WESCO.

Article 101 - On a permanent basis, there may not be the cumulative exercise of positions in powers and bodies other than WESCO, while the simultaneous exercise of positions in the powers or organs of an entity shall not be permanently prohibited .

Sole Paragraph - For the purposes of the provisions of this article, a permanent exercise is understood to be one whose duration exceeds 180 (one hundred and eighty) days. Art. 101 - WESCO will only recognize the titles won in national and regional and municipal level competitions promoted respectively by the national and regional administrations entities (Federations) and the non- professional electronic sports municipal administration entities affiliated to the Federations.

Article 102 - It is recommended to the national and regional administration entities (Federations), the adoption of the limitation of mandates to their respective Presidents, in the terms established in art. 33 of these By-Laws.

Paragraph One - The exception to that is the main provision of this article does not have applicability or effectiveness if Brazil did not come to be chosen and ratified by WESCO to host referred Cup the World event in which the mandate of the elected members will obey the rule generally provided for in Article 33 of these Statutes.

Art. 103 - WESCO will create rules to regulate the club licensing system, aiming to establish new standards of governance and responsible administration in professional electronic sports clubs, which will contain minimum criteria and requirements.

- (i) sports,
- (ii) administrative and personnel,
- (iii) infrastructure,
- (iv) financial and
- (v) legal, which clubs must fulfill to be admitted to competitions coordinated by WESCO, upon the granting of an annual license.

Art. 104 - The status of this come into force and will effectively full, in its entirety, from the 09 April 2019 date of completion of the Extraordinary General Meeting of WESCO, that the approved.
